- Eucalyptus globulus (Blue Gum)
- Eucalyptus strzelckii (Strzeleki Gum)
- Eucalyptus regnans (Mountain Ash)
- Cassinia sp.
- Kunzea sp.
- Olearia sp.
- Bedfordia arborescens (Blanket Leaf)
- Acacia melanoxylon (Blackwood)
- Acacia verticillata (Prickly Moses)
- Goodenia ovata (Hop Goodenia)

It was a great experience to be a part of and Greenworx look forward to attending the planting days again next year across NSW, VIC and QLD!



## **BRRRR-ILLIANT LANDSCAPE AND MAINTENANCE TASKS FOR THE WINTER SEASON!**

The winter season and reduced growth provides us with a greater opportunity to manage and improve the health and maintenance of gardens. Some of these tasks can include

- **Raking and collecting accumulated leaf litter:** Deciduous trees will continue to or completely lose their leaves in the cooler months of the year and this can negatively impact gardens and lawns. Build up can smother other ground covers and cause water to run off rather than be absorbed into the profile. It also doesn't look really good. :)
- **Mulching garden beds:** maintaining mulch levels around garden beds, trees and plants will assist with moisture retention and weed control. It can also help with maintaining optimal temperatures in the soil profile.
- **Pruning dormant shrubs and trees:** Pruning the plants during the cooler months can allow for preparation of new growth for spring.

- **Clean gutters:** Gutters can fill with leaves and debris during the winter months so it is important to remove this to ensure the water flow in the pipes and drain pits are not restricted. Blocked drains and pipes can impact water run off and can lead to flooding.


## TRAINING
